



LIBRARY COMMITTEE

The Library Committee is a Standing Committee of the Academic Senate.

Terms of Reference

1. To advise the University Librarian on the needs of readers and on the present and future needs of the Library.
2. To advise the University Librarian on the rules and conditions of use of the Library.
3. To consider and advise on such matters as the Academic Senate or the Vice-Chancellor may refer to it.

The Committee shall not be concerned with the day-to-day operations of the Library which shall be under the management of the University Librarian.

Membership

- a. A chairperson appointed by the Academic Senate
- b. Ex officio members: Vice-Chancellor Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic) Pro Vice-Chancellor (eLearning and Information Services) Vice-President of Academic Senate University Librarian Deputy University Librarian Director, Centre for Flexible Learning Director, IT Services
- c. One member appointed by the University Council Two members appointed by the Academic Senate One member appointed by and from each Division Two members elected by and from the staff of the Library
- d. Two undergraduate student members appointed by the Students Council
- e. One postgraduate student appointed by the Postgraduate Representative Association

Term of Office

For categories a. and c.: 3 years; for category d.: 1 year.

The secretary will maintain a register of members and their terms of office. Casual vacancies will be filled by nomination by the relevant nominating body (categories a. and c.), or by reference to the previous election (category d.).
